



# What are we learning in Nursery this term?

Dear Parents/Carers



We hope you had a wonderful summer and that your children are enjoying being back in/starting nursery. They have settled in extremely well and it's been lovely watching them play together and form new friendships.



This term our first topic will be 'All About Me'. Children will be encouraged to talk about themselves - their likes and dislikes, what they look like and what they are good at. We will also explore what makes us unique and different from each other.



As we enter the season of Autumn we will discuss what we already know about Autumn and how the world around us changes during this time. We'll enjoy using our senses outside to look for signs of Autumn and use stories such as 'The Gruffalo' and 'We're Going on a Leaf Hunt' to further our understanding.



We will also learn about the Harvest Festival and we'll use a Farm Shop role play area to learn about seasonal vegetables and how they grow, as well as joining in with the whole school celebrations.

Towards the end of the half term we will celebrate Diwali - the Festival of Light, and enjoy some fun Halloween activities.

Many of the activities will be guided by the children by following their interests and suggestions. We will promote British Values and ask the children to vote on what they would like our child interest role play area to be.
